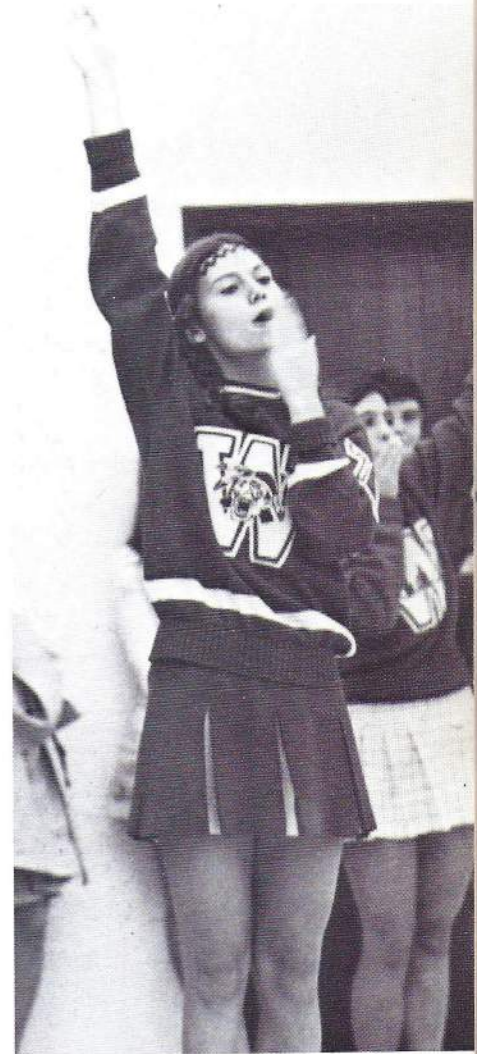
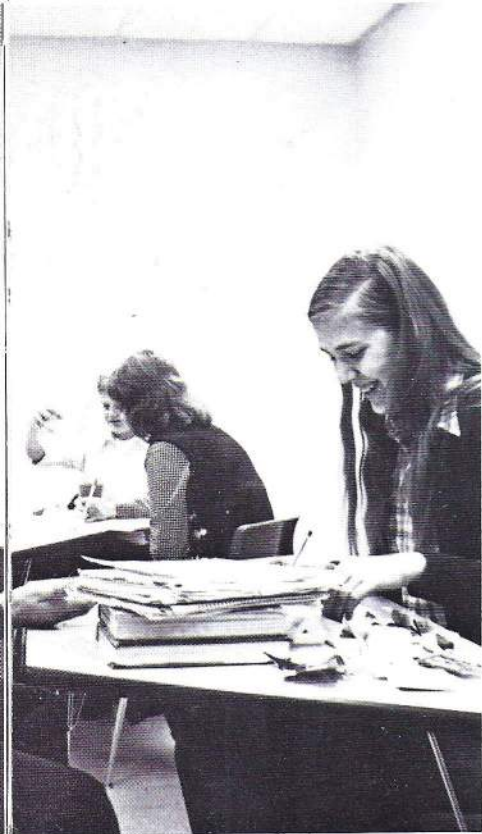




Activities
